Policing

AuP asked what had been accepted/ rejected in Public Realm OLF works in respect of street safety. Update will be provided after steering group meeting 17.04.13. Action **OU**

Casual labourers –sustained operation in early part of 2013 were successful but police do not have resources to continue at the same level. DM explained that CIP are working with GLA and others to establish if funding is available via European Commission so as to manage the numbers and reduce loitering, crime and anti-social behaviour. DM confirmed he would keep Sgt Gibbs informed of progress. Action **DM/RG**

Town Team

RG outlined the 10 steps guide for Town Teams and advised the committee members that CIP were exploring the idea of becoming a Town team.

OU outlined that the creation of a Town Team was a requirement of the OLF funding and part of the exit strategy and a Town Team would be able to apply for funding akin to OLF funding.

DM – EmpowerUs – empowerment movement part of Co-operative who provide legal advise to Groups like CIP and having met with them today they will have something ready to be agreed by end of this week. A CIC is a favourite with other Groups like CIP as a CIC allows groups to fundraise from charitable trusts. Action **DM**

Mobile Town Square – all asked to spread the word about the mobile Town square and submit ideas/uses for Mobile Town Square. Sgt Gibbs confirmed his team may do a crime workshop one of the days. RG to circulate an expression of interest form to attendees. Action **RG**
